Sydney's Neutral Bay isn't renowned for culinary highlights, but a spate of recent additions, including Mauro Marcucci's (of *Pizza e Birra* fame) *Enopizzeria*, and a North Shore version of Walsh Bay wine bar, *Firefly*, is changing all that. Rocks eatery *Pony* is also due to open an outpost here before Christmas, while one of the stars of this burgeoning foodie scene is undoubtedly **Neutral Bay Bar & Dining**. The slick establishment (from the Glebe Point Diner team) is low on
