



Baked chocolate pudding with chocolate sorbet at Neutral Bay Bar & Dining

Death by Chocolate lives again in this lovely little baked chocolate pudding, coated in a rich, hot, molten sauce and served with an equally rich, smooth chocolate sorbet (\$16). It's hot, it's cold and it's all made from 53-per-cent-cocoa Callebaut couverture for just the right bitter-sweetness. It's typical of the no-fuss cooking style honed by Alex Kearns at his much-loved Glebe Point Diner. Now very much at home in Neutral Bay, he's serving everything from grilled scotch fillet or whole snapper to freshly opened oysters and highly seasonal salads. Even the decor is straight-up simple, from the woodsy front bar to the monastic dining room with its high-backed wooden pews.

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
